



The Falkland Islands Government has confirmed permission for the research cruise and has further stated that they would appreciate copies of the research data and reports. Raw data on Exabyte tape is acceptable as the British Geological Survey can add it to the Island's geological archive and copy it to DAT tape for the Fisheries Department. However, if the survey team can provide the data in DAT format as well, it would be appreciated.

The Department would like to remind the Embassy that notification of marine scientific research within the United Kingdom limits must be given at least three months before research is scheduled to begin.

The Department would be grateful to receive in due course a copy of the report for this cruise. It would be helpful if the attached standard Roscop form could be used for this purpose.

The Aviation, Maritime and Energy Department avails itself of this opportunity to express to the Embassy of the United States of America the assurances of its highest consideration.
