The Ministry of Foreign Relations presents its compliments to the Embassy of the United States of America and with reference to its Note No. 090 of April 3, 2003, has the honor to inform TH Embassy that, after consulting with the appropriate authorities, authorization has been granted for the R/V Roger Revelle to conduct scientific research in waters under Chilean jurisdiction, within the framework of its cruise of November 5 to 30, 2003, between Manta (Ecuador) and Arica (Chile).

This authorization has been granted under the following conditions:

- a) That the research be conducted within the Exclusive Economic Zone and Chile's Territorial Sea up to three (3) nautical miles from the coast, while navigating between the geographic point Latitude 20°S and Longitude 85°W and Arica.
- b) That a representative of the Hydrographic and Oceanographic Service of the Navy (SHOA) should participate during all of the research in Chilean jurisdictional waters, to embark in Ecuador and disembark in Arica.
- c) That upon concluding the research, a technical report of the work done in Chilean jurisdictional waters be delivered to SHOA, through its assigned representative on board, attaching a copy of all parameters, oceanographic information, and other data obtained.

The Ministry of Foreign Relations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the United States of America the assurances of its highest and most distinguished consideration.
